Products allowed: Original Art, Handcrafted and Re-Purposed items only. No resale. **Vendor must email photos of work for prior approval to BloomandBark@netins.net.**

Set up: Is outside in a wooded area, with lots of shade. Bring your own tent, table, chairs, etc. Note: This year we have one spot available in our 3 bay garage. Only the center spot is available as the other two need to be open for access to walk-in cooler and restroom.

Electricity: Electricity is available but limited and can only be used for **low power usage only** (lights, fan, etc.). Absolutely **No Electric Heaters.** You must bring your own exterior extension cords. Fee for electric use is \$8.

Restroom: A modern restroom is available.

Set up time: Friday 10/11/2024 (10am-6pm) or Saturday 10/12/2024 (6am-9:30am) Must be set up by 9:30am As we get closer to these dates please email, call or text with approximate set up time so we can be sure someone will be here to assist you. If you need a different set up time – just ask, we are pretty easy.

Show time: 10/12/2024 (10am-4pm **No early tear down**). Please be ready to go by 9:30am. Shoppers start arriving at 9:30am

Vendor Fee: \$20 *Note: Cost of the garage spot is \$30.*

Non-compete clause and Products Sold: The following products cannot be sold without prior approval.

Glass Blown Art

Bread

Bottle Water

Any other product that is sold by Bloom and Bark, LLC

Any product that is deemed inappropriate or unacceptable by Bloom and Bark, LLC

We work very hard not to have any duplication of products during our events.

Permits: Vendors are responsible for all licenses, permits, sales tax and insurance required to operate your business.

Trash: Any trash you bring in must go home with you when you tear down and leave the farm.

Firearms and Weapons: Firearms and Weapons are prohibited on Bloom and Bark Farm by both vendors and visitors.
